Computer Competencies

Learning online will be greatly facilitated if you have some basic computer skills before enrolling in a Web course. You can acquire these skills on your own or by attending continuing education classes at a local library or community college.

Check off whether you can do the following:

- Browse the Web.
- Recognize a Web link.
- Use the Back and Forward buttons.

- Print Web pages.
- Create and edit bookmarks/favorites.
- Download and install software from the Web (Google Chrome, Adobe Reader, ect.).

- Use Microsoft Windows or Apple Macintosh.
- Connect to the Web using broadband.
- Type using a Microsoft Word or other compatible word processor.
- Open a file or document, save a file or document, and "save as" a different file type.

- Develop a presentation using Microsoft PowerPoint.
- Send and receive e-mail and print messages.
- Attach files to e-mail.

- Cut, copy, and paste text.
- Move, copy, and delete files (for example, using My Computer or Windows Explorer).
